Description:

Scholarship awardees will be recognized at the **27th Annual Scholarship Fundraiser and Chinese New Year Celebration held in person on Saturday, February 11, 2023, from 5 PM – 8 PM at Three Oaks Community Center located at 1100 Alamo Drive, Vacaville.**

Applicant Eligibility:

Open to all full-time students meeting the requirements below. Must be a high school senior or community college student in Solano County or a resident of Solano County attending high school or a community college.

- 1) Applicant must possess a **minimum weighted grade point average (GPA) of 3.0.**
- 2) **Three letters of recommendation** must accompany the application from separate individuals, none of whom are related to the applicant.
- 3) Past recipients of the CAASC scholarship are not eligible.

Basis of Award:

Academic performance, scholastic aptitude, community service, and community involvement.

- 2) **Completed applications must be received at the CAASC office located at 185 Butcher Road Vacaville, CA 95687 by 5 p.m. on December 9, 2022. Postmarked applications not received by the deadline are not accepted.**
